# Knit Scarf

## Beginner Knitting

### MEASUREMENTS

Width at widest point (approx) 110 cm

Depth (approx) 45 cm

**YARN** *(We suggest using the yarn stated to achieve the style pictured)*

**Natural 50g** x 2 balls

### NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

A pair 5mm knitting needles; wool needle.

### TENSION

Not essential for this project.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**approx** = approximate, **beg** = beginning, **cm** = centimeters, **cont** = continue, **garter st** = every row knit, **K** = knit, **rep** = repeat, **RS** = right side, **st/s** = stitch/es, **tog** = together, **WS** = wrong side.

### SCARF

**Tassels** - Make 2 tassels approx 10cm in length, wrapping yarn approx 25 times around cardboard. Set aside.

Using 5mm needles, cast on 3 sts.

**1st row (RS)** - Knit - mark this side of work with a stitch marker to help identify the RS of your work.

**2nd row** - Knit.

**3rd row** - K1, increase knitways in next st by knitting into the front and then back of stitch, K1 = 4 sts.

**4th row** - Knit.

**5th row** - K1, increase knitways in next st (as before), knit to end = 5 sts.

Rep last 2 rows until there is enough yarn remaining to cast off, working last row on WS.

Cast off loosely knitways.

### FINISHING

Sew in ends towards centre of work, rather than along side edges. Attach a tassel securely to each end of scarf as pictured.
