Nimbus Cowl Easy Knitting

MEASUREMENTS

Depth (approx) 27 cm

Circumference (approx) 68 cm

YARN *(We suggest using the yarn stated to achieve the style pictured)*

Coast 50g 2 x balls

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

A pair 4.50mm knitting needles, or size needed to give correct tension; wool needle.

TENSION

20 sts to 10cm in width over patt, using 4.50mm needles.

To work approx a 12.5cm x 12.5cm tension square, using 4.50mm needles, cast on 25 sts.

Work in patt as for Cowl until work measures 12.5cm from beg, working last row on WS. Cast off loosely.

If less sts use smaller needles, if more sts use larger needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt = alternate, **approx** = approximate, **beg** = beginning, **cm** = centimeters, **cont** = continue, **incl** = inclusive, **K** = knit, **P** = purl, **patt** = pattern, **rep** = repeat, **RS** = right side, **st/s** = stitch/es, **tog** = together, **WS** = wrong side.

COWL

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 55 sts.

Beg patt - 1st row (RS) - K5, * (P1, K1) 3 times, K4, rep from * to end.

2nd row - K4, * (P1, K1) 3 times, P1, K3, rep from * to last st, K1.

3rd row - K1, * K5, P1, K1, P1, K2, rep from * to last 4 sts, K4.

4th row - K4, * P2, K1, P1, K1, P2, K3, rep from * to last st, K1.

Rows 1 to 4 incl form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx 68 cm from beg or until enough yarn remains to cast off and sew seam, and ending with a 2nd or 4th row.

Cast off loosely.

FINISHING

Using a flat seam, neatly join cast on and cast off edges together to form centre back seam. Sew in all ends towards centre of cowl rather than along side edges for a neater finish.
